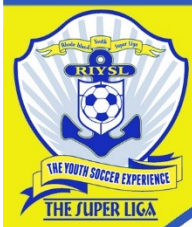

COACH'S PRINCIPLES OF CONDUCT

Super Liga expects all coaches during any games or events to conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike and professional manner. RIYSL wants to ensure that all its participants will have a positive and enjoyable experience. A soccer game should be a fair, friendly, competitive and most of all an enjoyable match that involves the cooperation and support of all coaches, referees, players and parents



COACH'S PRINCIPLES OF CONDUCT

- SAFETY of all players.
- Develop the player's appreciation and passion for the game.
- Allow players to be creative, make decisions and give feedback.
- Keep winning and losing in perspective.
- Be positive role model.
- Set the standard for sportsmanship.



PARENTAL CODE OF CONDUCT

- Maintain high standards of sportsmanship and appropriate conduct for themselves.
- Abusive, confrontational and inappropriate language or behavior detrimental to any individual, before, during or after a game will not be tolerated.
- Allow, players to play; coaches to coach; referees to officiate and spectators to support, at all times.
- Failure to do so will undermine the integrity of the game and the authority of coaches/referees. This could potentially lead to a hostile environment and one that we cannot allow the players to witness.



PARENTAL CODE OF CONDUCT

All parents are asked to agree to follow the following Code of Conduct:

“I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support to all players (not just my own or my team), coaches and referees at every game, training session or any other Super Liga event.”



SPORTSMANSHIP CARD

The card is read to home and visiting team's coaches, players and spectators prior to the game.



The **SUPER LIGA** Sportsmanship Card

The Super Liga's philosophy is to provide a fun filled and safe environment to create the "Youth Soccer Experience".

We encourage coaches, players, referees, and spectators to respect each other and the game by creating a positive and enthusiastic environment. Poor sportsmanship will not be tolerated.

It is the referee's discretion to terminate the game if any threatening statements are made or for anyone entering the field of play without permission.

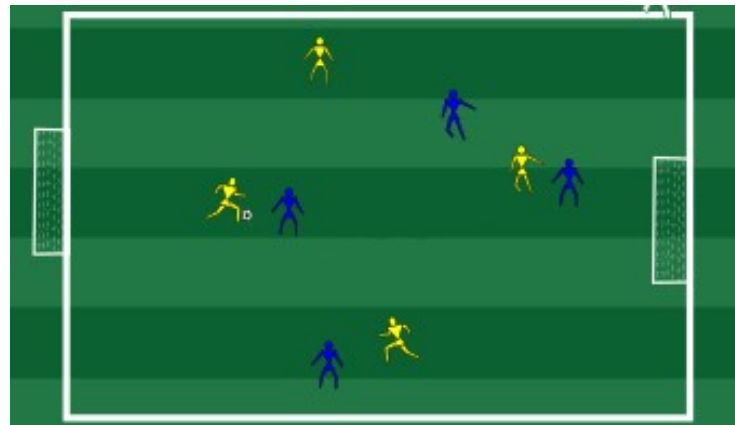
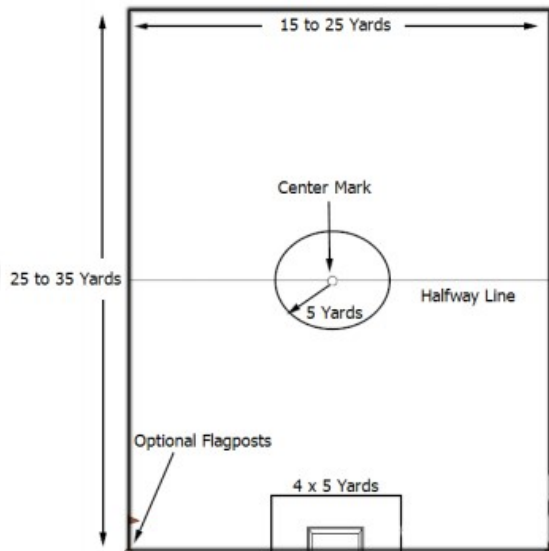

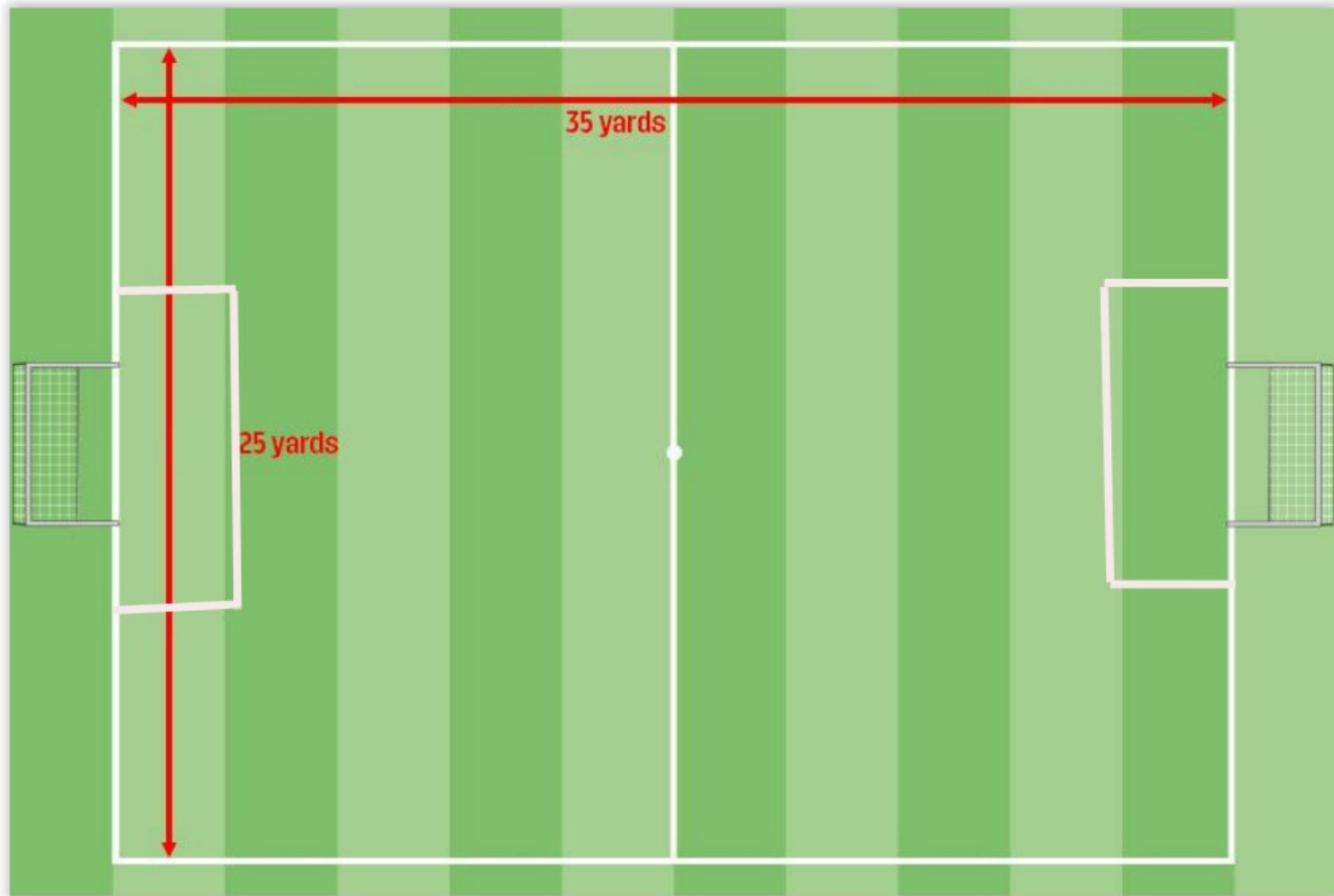

LAW 5 - THE REFEREE

- One Referee per game: Referee Fee = \$20 (\$10/team)

LAW 6 – ASSISTANT REFEREE

- None required

LAW 7 – DURATION OF THE MATCH

- 4 Quarters – 12 minutes each

LAW 8 - THE START AND RESTART OF PLAY

- Restart after a goal: From the center circle.

LAW 10 - THE METHOD OF SCORING

- Conform to FIFA rules



8U 4 V 4 FORMAT

LAW 11 - OFFSIDES

- There will be no offsides in the 8U age group

LAW 12 – FOULS & MISCONDUCTS

- Conform with FIFA with the following modifications...
- All fouls will be INDIRECT FREE KICKS
- opponent 5 yards away
- Fouls inside the goal box will result in ball being placed 5 yards outside the goal box (this allows opponent to establish a wall)
- The referee shall explain all infractions to the offending players

LAW 13 – FREE KICKS

- All FREE KICKS will be INDIRECT
- opponent must be 5 yards away from the ball

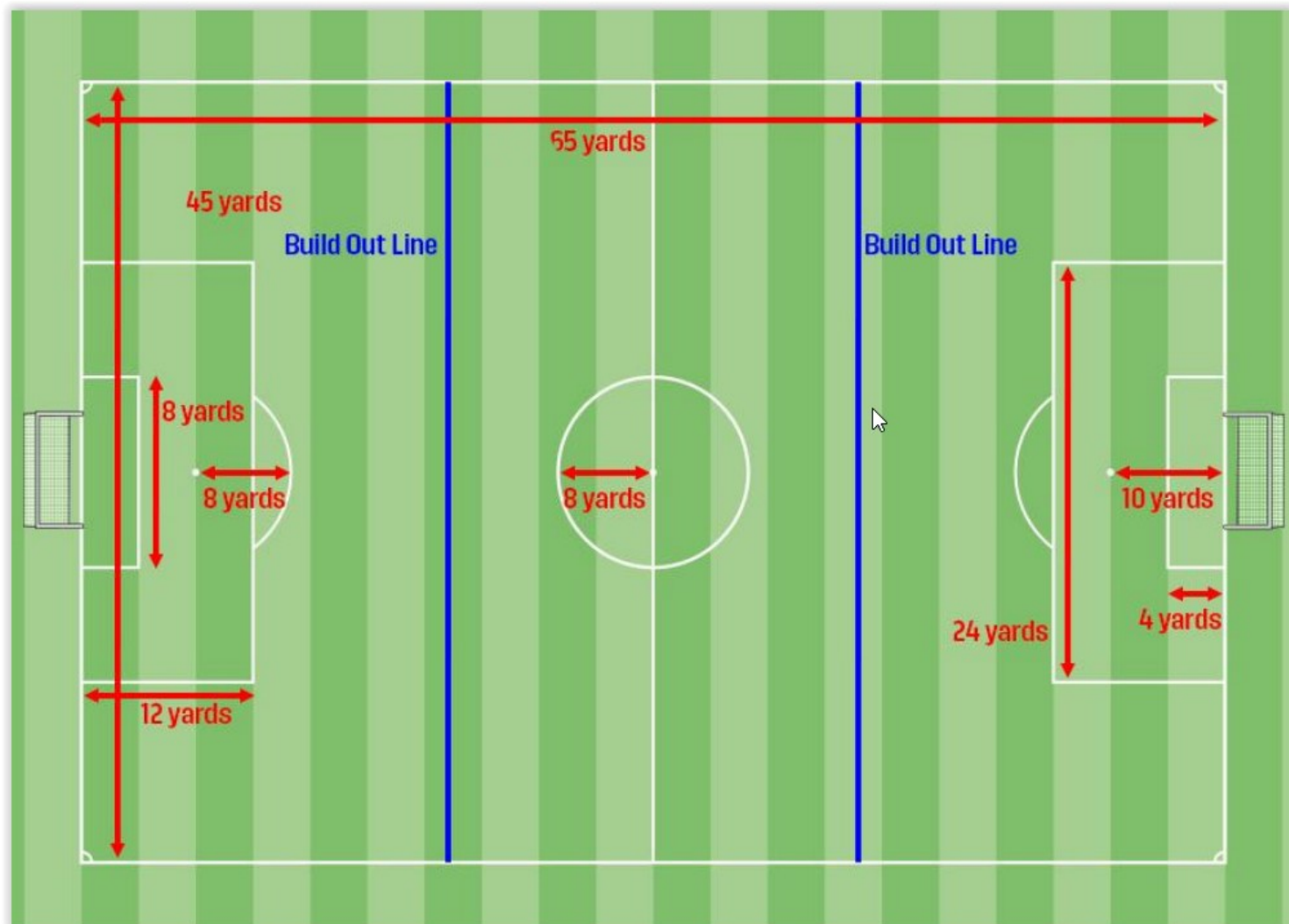

LAW 5 - THE REFEREE

- One Referee per game

LAW 6 – ASSISTANT REFEREE

- Two Assistant Referees

LAW 7 – DURATION OF THE MATCH

- 2 Halves – 25 minutes each

LAWS 8 - 16

- Conform to FIFA rules



9U-10U PLAYING FORMAT AND RULES

BUILD OUT LINES

The build out line promotes playing the ball out of the back in a less pressured setting.

- When the goalkeeper has the ball in his or her hands during play from the opponent, the opposing team must move behind the build out line until the ball is put into play.
- Once the opposing team is behind the build out line, the goalkeeper can pass, throw or roll the ball into play (punts and drop kicks are not allowed).



9U-10U PLAYING FORMAT AND RULES

BUILD OUT LINES

- After the ball is put into play by the goalkeeper, the opposing team can cross the build out line and play resumes as normal.
- The opposing team must also move behind the build out line during a goal kick until the ball is put into play and clears the penalty area.
- If a goalkeeper punts or drop kicks the ball, an indirect free kick should be awarded to the opposing team from the spot of the offense.
- If the punt or drop kick occurs within the goal area, the indirect free kick should be taken on the goal area line parallel to the goal line at the nearest point to where the infringement occurred.



9U-10U PLAYING FORMAT AND RULES

BUILD OUT LINES

- The build out line will also be used to denote where offside offenses can be called. Players cannot be penalized for an offside offense between the halfway line and the build out line. Players can be penalized for an offside offense between the build out line and the goal line .
- Ideally, the goalkeeper will wait to put the ball into play once all opponents are past the build out line. However, the goalkeeper can put the ball into play sooner.



SafeSoccer Goals

- **ALL GOALS MUST BE ANCHORED PROPERLY PRIOR TO ANY SOCCER BEING PLAYED ON ANY SOCCER FIELD.**
- Home Team Responsibility
- Referees will not start the game without the Goals anchored properly.



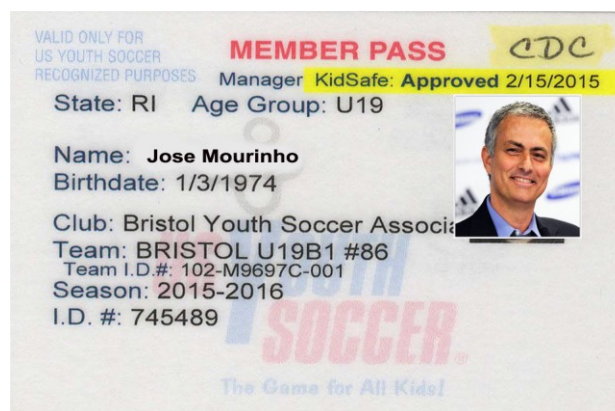

PLAYERS & COACHES PASSES

- Every Player and Coach **must** have a current USYS Pass.
- The passes can be a physical laminated pass or a virtual pass on any mobile device.

NO PASS > NO PLAY , NO COACH



MAX of 3 Coaches allowed in Coach's Box



SUPER LIGA'S CLUB PASS POLICY

Club Pass can only be used within an association/club's teams in Super Liga and not with another association/club's teams.

- All players must be rostered to one Super Liga team.
- Club Pass Players' names must be written on the game day roster, with their team number and their passes must be shown to the referee.
- No Limitation on number of games a player can play in a day/weekend.



SUPER LIGA'S CLUB PASS POLICY

- Unlimited players can be moved within the 8U-10U age groups, or to a higher age group, to the maximum of four substitutes.
- Players can move down an age group, if they are playing up in a higher age group, up to maximum of four substitutes.
- No Anchor player can move up to a Rhody team, in all age groups.
- Club Pass can be used until the end of the season.
- Any violation of the Club Pass policy will result in a game forfeit, fine and a coach's one game suspension.



PLAYER DUAL ROSTER POLICY

- Any Super Liga player can be dual rostered within their association/club for Super Liga play.
- No Player can be dual rostered on an Anchor and Rhody team.
- No Team can have more than 30 % of their roster with dual rostered players.
- Dual rostered players must play more than 50% of the games for both teams. Violation of this part of the policy will result the player being disqualified for the playoffs.

Super Liga will be tracking the dual roster players.

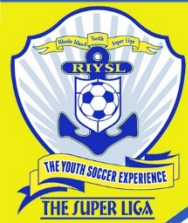

GOAL DIFFERENTIAL POLICY

If a team's winning score of a Super Liga game is a nine goal differential:

- First Offense- A warning.
- Second Offense, a point deduction from the standings.
- Third Offense, two points deduction from the standings and coach serves an one game suspension.

If a team 's winning score of a Super Liga game is a ten goal differential or more:

- The coach will be suspended for the following two Super Liga games and a point deducted for the standings.
- Second offense the coach would be suspended for the remainder or the competition

NOTE: If an unordinary situation occurs RIYSL will have discretion.



USF HEADING POLICY

Based on the United States Soccer Federation's recommendation, the Rhode Island Youth Super Liga, llc, has implemented the following policy.....

- ✓ All players 10 years old and younger, shall not engage in heading in practice/training or in games





USF HEADING POLICY

When a player deliberately heads the ball in a game....

An indirect free kick (IFK) will be awarded to the opposing team from the spot of the offense

If a player does not deliberately head the ball, then play should continue.

If the deliberate header occurs within the goal area, the indirect free kick will be taken on the goal area line parallel to the goal line at the point nearest to where the infringement occurred

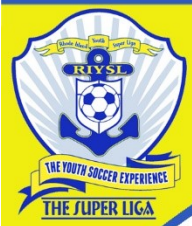

LIGHTNING POLICY

- Coaches and Referees need to communicate with each other prior to start of game- if there are thunderstorms in the forecast during the game.
- If lightning is observed by any referee or coaches, the referee will stop the game immediately.
- Referee must wait 20 Minutes between observing lightning before the game can resume.
- **Maximum 40 minute delay before terminating game**
- Game terminated in the 1st half
 - Referee crew keeps half the game fee
- Game terminated at half-time and beyond
 - Referee crew keeps game fee.
