SUPER LIGA COVID19 Policy

COVID19 Coordinator

Ensure CDC/RIDOH guidelines are adhered to, prior to, during and after each Super Liga game.



SUPER LIGA COVID19 Policy

COVID19 Coordinator

- Must be present at all home games.
- Must wear a face mask.
- Introduce themselves to both teams and referees.



SUPER LIGA COVID19 Policy

HOME TEAM Responsibilities

- Refer to the Super Liga Policies & Rules Handbook
- Additional Responsibilities
 - Ensure that all equipment has been sanitized prior to, during and after each game.
 - Restroom facilities are sanitized.
 - Designate teams and spectator areas.
 - Spectator lines must 14 ft from the touch line.
 - Sanitized soccer balls.



SUPER LIGA COVID19 Policy

COACHES Responsibilities

- Refer to the Super Liga Policies & Rules Handbook
- Additional Responsibilities
 - All coaches must wear masks at all times.
(no gaiters)
 - Sanitize all equipment when required.
 - Go through pregame check with players.
 - Not allow any player who shows any signs of illness.
 - Ensure that all players' equipment is neatly spaced 6' apart.
 - Have ample supply of sanitizer.
 - At any time prior to, during or after the conclusion of each game, players and coaches are not allowed to shake hands or high five each other. Hand waves from a distance is recommended.



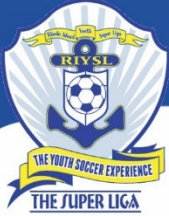
SUPER LIGA COVID19 Policy

- **PARENTS/PLAYERS Responsibilities**
 - Go through COVID19 screening tool 15 minutes prior to coming to the field.
 - Players must always wear masks and need to bring extra masks to each game should they need to replace the one they are using.
 - Bring own water bottle and ample water supply.
 - Bring own hand sanitizer and sanitize hands at appropriate opportunities.
 - Sanitize their personal equipment prior to and after each game.



SUPER LIGA COVID19 Policy

- **PARENTS/SPECTATORS Responsibilities**
 - Must always wear masks.
 - Must socially distance.
 - Every player will be allowed to two spectators
At each game, **does not include siblings under 18.**
 - Spectators must be 14' from the touch and social distance from other spectators.
 - Spectators are required to take their own trash with them.
 - Spectators and players must disburse immediately following the conclusion of the game.



SUPER LIGA COVID19 Policy

- **REFEREE Responsibilities**
 - Refer to the Super Liga Policies & Rules Handbook
 - Additional Responsibilities
 - All referee must always wear masks.
(no gaiters)
 - Referees must use electronic whistles or other approved means.
 - Understand all modified policies and rules.
 - Have ample supply of hand sanitizer.



SUPER LIGA COVID19 Policy

- Substitutes waiting to get in the game must social- distance with any other Substitutes
- Coaches/ Players boxes can be expanded further down the touch line to ensure proper social distancing.
- Coaches however must stay within the standard coaching area and at least 6 feet from the touchline.
- 2-minute Hydration Break, midway through each half.
 - Players check masks.
 - Sanitize hands and balls.
 - Players hydrate themselves.



SUPER LIGA RULES & POLICIES HANDBOOK

- Coaches & Referees are required to understand all rules and policies for Super Liga.
